- 1. What is the history of your agency and the grant you receive as part of your partnership with the American Job Center?**

The Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Program has been operated by the Lincoln Housing Authority since 1993. The partnership with American Job Center started in June of 2017. Lincoln Housing Authority is a required partner because we operate the federal Family Self-Sufficiency Program which falls under employment and training activities carried out by the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

- 2. What services do you offer and how would someone apply?**

The FSS coordinator can help you find the services you need to become self-sufficient. These may include: Educational programs (GED, ESL, ABE and college), Career assessments, Job training, Child care, Counseling, Case management, Credit counseling, Home ownership preparation, and Coordination with other service providers and agencies.

- 3. What qualifies someone to receive your services?**

Need to be housed in Lincoln Housing Authority's Housing Choice Voucher or Public Housing Program and are interested in seeking and maintaining employment.

- 4. Is there a time limit for your services or can someone continue to receive them for as long as needed?**

An individual or household can be enrolled in FSS for 5-7 years.

The Family Self-Sufficiency Coordinator will provide supportive and referral services throughout the entire involvement in the program and help participants achieve their goals to work towards employment and/or home ownership.
