He and is ready and willing to access the support of the Community Corrections Center and the AJC to help him with a positive return to society. Mr. Minor first visited the AJC to search for employment on February 15, 2022. The AJC resource team assisted him with an initial assessment by having him complete the AJC Program Matcher to determine what programs may be available if he wanted more individualized services. The team assisted him developing a resume, and with how to respond to questions regarding his gap of employment and his background. Mr. Minor applied for the WIOA adult program and was provided resources to assist him with his long-term goal of becoming an entrepreneur. Mr. Minor attended a walk-in hiring event with Sysco and was interviewed on the spot and set up for pre-employment screening. Mr. Minor was hired by Sysco and is set to begin employment on March 14, 2022, as a Pallet Jacker, making \$18.00/ hour which is considered a living wage.
