Mr. Craig R Pounds started our program with a participation date of 3/9/2020. In the beginning he appeared to struggle with finding an occupation that would match his skills, interests and experience and spent some time career planning and researching where he thought he could feel the most fulfilled in his career. During that time, he was also struggling with balancing time as he was the primary care giver to his mother who was experiencing health difficulties. He remained persistent in his search, however, working through finding the confidence to re-enter the workforce. He proceeded at a pace in which he felt comfortable and career planners were able to support him through. He was able to complete courses through AIM Code School in Specialization in Web Development: JAVA and earned the accompanying certificate. He did continue to put his best foot forward at a pace he was comfortable with and through working with WIOA and AJC has built the confidence and practiced the skills necessary to feel confident about returning to work and in January 2023 he accepted a position with DHHS through their SOS program in a year long contract and the option to transfer into a

permanent position at the end of that time. This opportunity was one that came through the American Job Center with an in-office job fair he attended.


