Program Spotlight: Ticket to Work Program

Ticket to Work is a free and voluntary program that is available to persons aged 18 to 64 who have a disability and receive Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and/or Supplemental Security Income (SSI).

Services:

- Assistance with wage reporting to Social Security.
- Access to comprehensive benefits planning with certified benefits planners on site.
- Help identifying and obtaining accommodations in the workplace.
- Assistance communicating with your employer if needed.
- Individualized Case Management Services for the duration of your ticket assignment.
- Resume, cover letter, application, and interview assistance.
- Career counseling and job placement assistance.
- Help developing an individual work plan and goals.
- Veteran Employment Services.
- Transitional Youth Services.
- Pass Plan assistance.
